Question	Correct Answer	Grammar Rule / Explanation
(1)	A	<b>a</b> — Even though "university" begins with the vowel letter 'u', it is pronounced with a consonant "yu" sound, requiring the article "a".
(2)	B	<b>an</b> — The 'h' in "hour" is silent, so the word starts with a vowel sound. We use "an" before vowel sounds.
(3)	D	<b>(no article)</b> — Zero Article applies here because "honesty" is an abstract noun being discussed as a general idea.
(4)	B	<b>an</b> — "Honest" begins with a silent 'h' and results in a vowel sound, matching the exception rule to use "an".
(5)	C	<b>The</b> — The definite article "the" is required here because there is only one unique moon, and it refers to a specific celestial object.
(6)	C	<b>a / The</b> — Use "a" when introducing a general noun for the first time ("a dog"). Use "the" when mentioning that identical noun again ("The dog").
(7)	D	<b>(no article)</b> — Do not use articles when discussing broad general concepts or uncountable nouns like "water".
(8)	C	<b>the</b> — Use the definite article when the listener knows exactly which specific thing is being referenced (e.g., the specific door of the room).
(9)	A	<b>a</b> — Used when talking about a non-specific item or introducing something for the first time ("a new phone" out of many possibilities).
(10)	D	<b>(no article)</b> — Plural nouns used in a general sense ("cats") do not take an article when children are playing with them generally.
