Question	Correct Answer	Grammar Rule / Explanation
(1)	B	but — Coordinating conjunction used to connect two contrasting or opposing ideas (wanting a book vs. not having enough money).
(2)	D	because — Subordinating conjunction used to introduce a clause that states a reason or cause for an action.
(3)	A	or — Coordinating conjunction used to present a choice or alternative between two items or actions.
(4)	C	so — Coordinating conjunction used to show a result or consequence (cause: studying hard → result: getting perfect marks).
(5)	C	as — Subordinating conjunction used here to show time relationships, meaning "while" or "at the same time that".
(6)	A	until — Subordinating conjunction used to mean up to a specific time or event happening in the future.
(7)	C	Although — Subordinating conjunction used to show a concession or unexpected contrast (even though the weather was bad, they still played).
(8)	C	and — Coordinating conjunction used to connect or add words, phrases, or clauses together in a list.
(9)	A	unless — Subordinating conjunction that means "except if", introducing a negative condition required to change a situation.
(10)	B	since — Subordinating conjunction used to denote a starting point in time from a past event up to the present moment.
