Question	Correct Answer	Grammar Rule / Explanation
(1)	A	wolves — This tests collective nouns. A group of wild canine animals hunting together is called a "pack of wolves".
(2)	C	furniture — This tests uncountable nouns. "Furniture" is an uncountable noun and cannot be pluralized with an "s" ("furnitures" is incorrect).
(3)	B	honesty — This tests abstract nouns. The possessive pronoun "their" must be followed by a noun form ("honesty"), not an adjective ("honest") or adverb ("honestly").
(4)	A	bees — This tests collective nouns. A collection of insects flying together or living in a hive is referred to as a "swarm of bees".
(5)	C	children — This tests irregular plural nouns. The correct plural form of "child" is "children". Adding an "s" to form "childs" is a common error.
(6)	D	flour — This tests countable vs. uncountable expressions. "How much" is used only with uncountable singular nouns like "flour". ("Flours" and "sugar's" are incorrect).
(7)	C	employees — This tests regular plural nouns. The determiner "All the" implies a plural entity, requiring the plural noun "employees".
(8)	A	monument — This tests contextual concrete nouns. The Eiffel Tower is a tangible historical landmark, classifying it correctly as a "monument".
(9)	C	keys — This tests collective nouns. Objects like keys or grapes linked together structurally are referred to as a "bunch of keys".
(10)	D	silence — This tests abstract nouns vs. adjectives. The verb phrase "to maintain" acts upon an abstract entity/noun ("silence"), whereas "silent" is a descriptive adjective.
