ANSWER KEY & EXPLANATIONS

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Question	Correct Answer	Grammar Rule / Explanation
(1)	C	ours — A possessive pronoun is needed here to show ownership without following it with a noun. "Ours" means "our hideout".
(2)	A	them — The preposition "to" requires an object pronoun. "Them" is the correct object pronoun to replace "the twin sisters".
(3)	C	his — "His" functions as both a possessive adjective and a possessive pronoun. Here it acts as a possessive pronoun representing "David's bike".
(4)	A	itself — Reflexive pronouns are used when the subject and object are the same. The singular animal subject "it" pairs with "itself".
(5)	C	her — "Lent" takes an indirect object. "Her" is the correct female singular object pronoun, acting as the receiver of the card.
(6)	A	mine — The sentence sets up a comparison between two possessive pronouns ("yours" or "mine"). "My" requires a trailing noun, whereas "mine" stands alone.
(7)	B	themselves — Plural reflexive pronoun. "The primary students" is third-person plural, which correctly forms as "themselves" ("theirselves" is non-standard english).
(8)	C	yours — A possessive pronoun is required at the end of the phrase since no noun follows it. "Yours" represents "your pencils".
(9)	C	its — A possessive adjective is needed to modify the noun "tail". "Its" indicates ownership by an animal, while "it's" is a contraction for "it is".
(10)	A	us — The verb "told" requires an object pronoun to show who received the speech. "Us" is the objective counterpart to the subject pronoun "we".
